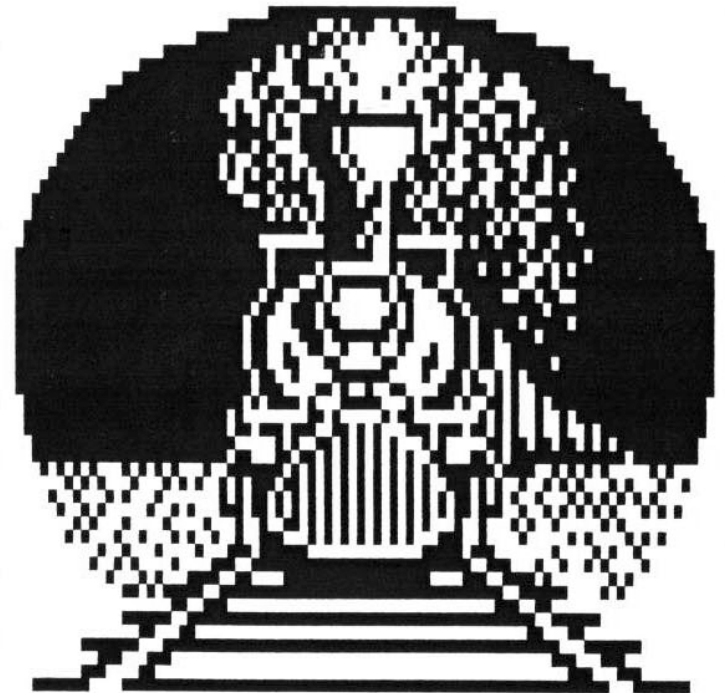

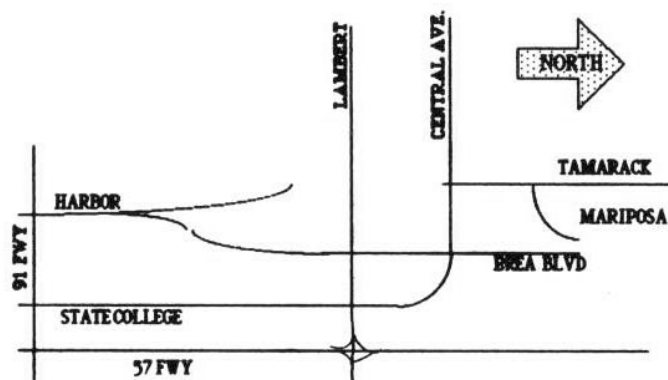
## SUMMER MEET
