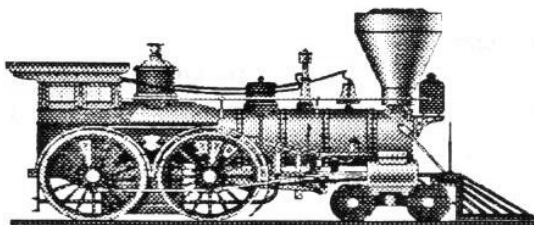

Thank you for all of your support. It was a close race and it took a long time to count all the ballots.

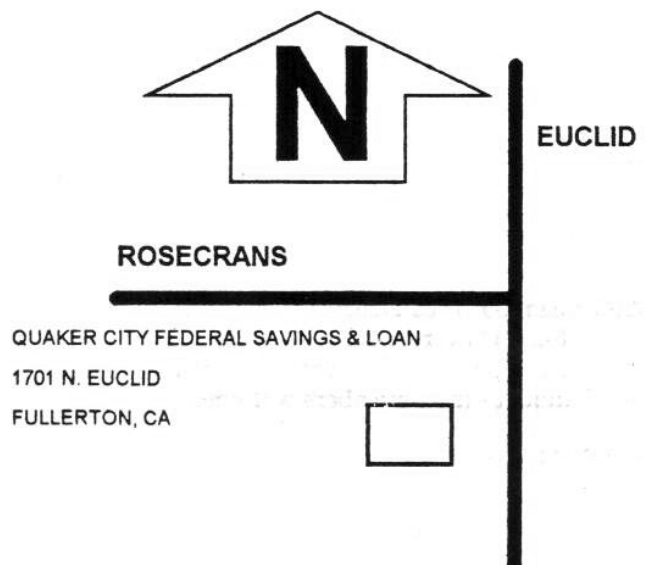

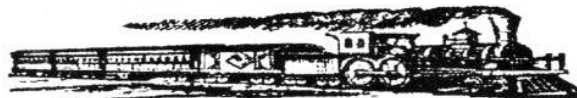

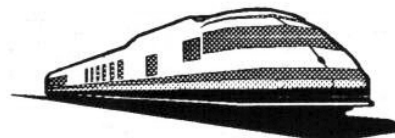
